2021 was almost a perfect growing season, though it began with a cold start, and lack of rain. The weather warmed up, but the drought continued. This was followed by weeks of steady daytime heat and cool evenings. The berries ripened evenly; however yields were a bit lighter than in prior vintages due to the lack of rainfall, resulting in grapes with loads of concentrated flavors.

After harvest, each lot was fermented and cave aged separately for 12 months, blended to showcase the vintage, then cave aged for an additional 12 months in French oak barrels to meld the flavors. Additional bottle aging resulted in a seamless blend.

This dark purple wine is filled with layered fruit aromas that hint at the complex flavors in the glass. Cassis, black cherry, cherry, dark chocolate, vanila and oak aromas lead to similar flavors. This vintage is a timeless classic with integrated tannins, beautiful balance, and a long, structured finish.
