

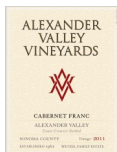

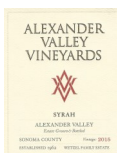
Cabernet Franc

Rich, lush wine with earthy flavors of plum, black cherry, vanilla and blueberry. Nicely balanced, great texture without the tannins. Extremely limited, small production 100% Cabernet Franc aged in French oak barrels. 2021: 92 points - James Suckling 750ml



Alexander School Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon

Single vineyard 100% Cabernet Sauvignon cave aged in French oak barrels. Winemaker Kevin Hall selects a single, unique lot to produce this one-of-a-kind Cab. The big flavors, intense concentration, deep color and layers of flavor showcase the Alexander Valley's best Cabernet Sauvignon. 2019: 95 points - Somm Journal; 92 points - James Suckling 750ml - 6 bottle case



Syrah

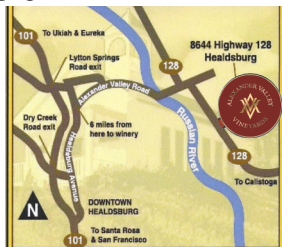
Small lot, whole berry fermentation contributes bright fruitiness and aging in toasty French oak barrels adds richness, while a little Viognier increases the aromatics and rounds out the wine. Lush flavors of blackberry, blueberry and vanilla with silky tannins and a long juicy finish. 2019: 93 points - Beverage Dynamics; 91 points - James Suckling 750ml



Dry Rose' of Sangiovese -

This Rose' explodes out of the glass with alluring pink color, enticing aromas and bright fruit. Medium-bodied with flavors of watermelon, strawberry and peach and nice minerality. Well-balanced with crisp acidity, a dry finish and very long aftertaste. 2023: 99 points & Double Gold Medal - CA State Fair; 2022: 90 points "Hidden Gem"- Wine Enthusiast 750ml stelvin closure

In 1962 Alexander Valley was mostly orchards and pasture when Maggie and Harry Wetzel purchased a portion of Cyrus Alexander's homestead. In 1963 they began planting premium grape varieties. In 1975 Hank Wetzel built their winery and produced AVV's first estate wines – quickly bringing recognition to the region.

Our vineyards stretch from the banks of the Russian River to the hillsides. Today, winemaker Kevin Hall creates balanced wines showcasing the grapes' varietal characteristics and the special valley that AVV calls home.

Sixty decades later, the third generation of our family is continuing the legacy of family farming and winemaking, and Alexander Valley Vineyards is known for hand crafted, elegant age-worthy wines.

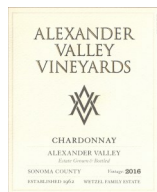

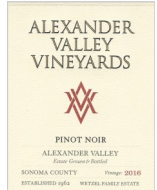

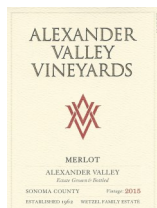
Chardonnay

Harvested from estate vineyards along the Russian River, our Chardonnay is dry, crisp and clean, with rich flavors of citrus fruits, peaches, green apples, minerals and vanilla. 30% fermented & aged in French Oak & 70% in stainless. 2022: 91 points - *Wine Enthusiast*; 95 points - *CA State Fair*; 91 points - *Press Democrat North Coast Wine Challenge* 750ml & 375ml stelvin



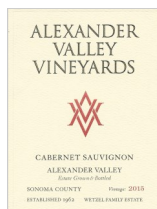
Pinot Noir

Small production wine, vineyards planted along the banks of the Russian River to three Burgundian clones and aged in French oak barrels. This is classic Pinot Noir with silky texture and lush flavors of plum, cherry, red-black fruits along with spicy notes of vanilla and cinnamon. 2022: 93 points - *CA State Fair*; 92 points - *Press Democrat North Coast Wine Challenge*; 2021: 93 points - *Wine Enthusiast* 750ml



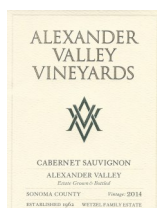
Merlot

A big, powerful Merlot with aromas of cassis & blackberry along with nuances of vanilla & cedar. The seductive rich flavors of blackberry, currant and cassis and toasty oak combined with supple tannins give our Merlot immediate appeal. Often called the "Cab lovers Merlot", it has a finish that just goes on and on. Aged for 14 months in French & American oak. 2020: 93 points & *Editors' Choice* - *Wine Enthusiast*; 90 points - *Decanter World Wine Awards* 375 ml stelvin; 750 ml



Cabernet Sauvignon

Our flagship wine - elegant with rich complex flavors of black cherry, plum, cassis, chocolate and spicy polished finish. Lots of finesse, enjoyable in its youth; and an age-worthy value for the wine cellar. 2021: 92 points - *James Suckling*; 2020: 97 points - *Beverage Dynamics*; 92 points - *James Suckling*, *Best of Show Red & Gold Medal* - *Monterey Wine Festival* 375 ml stelvin; 750 ml; 1.5 & 3L

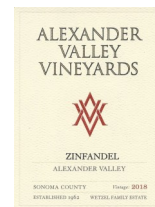


Cabernet Sauvignon - organically grown

This 100% Cabernet Sauvignon is harvested from a CCOF certified vineyard in the heart of the family estate. Extended barrel aging adds complexity to this rich and earthy wine. Aromas of dark fruits, chocolate and clove along with concentrated flavors of cherry, cassis, plum, blackberry, spice, oak and chocolate. 2020: 93 points - *Somm Journal*; 95 points - *BTI* 750 ml

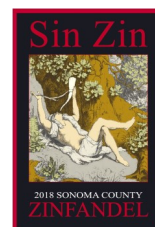
CYRUS

We select the finest estate lots for this rich Cabernet-based blend. 24 months barrel aging and extended bottle aging adds refinement and complexity. Intense aromas of black cherry, plum, cassis and chocolate combine with rich complex fruit, spicy oak, and a velvety mouth feel. Firm tannins, beautiful balance and a long finish give testament to the opulence of this wine. 2017: 98 points - *Beverage Dynamics*; 95 points - *Wine Enthusiast*; 92 points - *James Suckling*



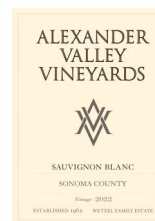
Zinfandel

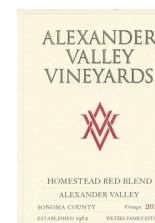
Sin Zin

Charming wine drinkers for over 40 years with aromas of cherry, plum, black pepper and wild strawberry and flavors of jammy red fruit - strawberry, raspberry and cherry along with classic black pepper & spice. Great acidity and elegant tannin make this a versatile and food-friendly wine. 2020: 91 points - *James Suckling*; 97 points & *Double Gold Medal* *Press Democrat North Coast Wine Challenge*; 91 points - *CA State Fair* 375 ml stelvin, 750 ml; 1.5L & 3.0L



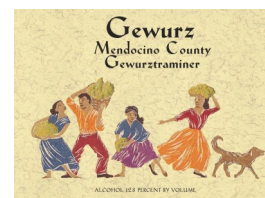
Sauvignon Blanc -

This lively white wine is has bright acidity with rich, yet juicy flavors of guava, citrus - lime, grapefruit, and lemongrass, along with slight minerality. 2022: 95 points & *Gold Medal* - *CA State Fair*; 92 points - *Tasting Panel* 750ml stelvin



Homestead Red Blend

We celebrate winemaking and family farming with this juicy, aromatic red blend. Dark purple with earthy aromas of berries, spice and violets. In the glass there are bright flavors of berry, plum, cherry, oak, vanilla and a touch of spice. Gewurz - organically grown

Cold fermentation in stainless steel preserves the expressive nose of pineapple, lychee and pear and flavors of grapefruit and apple along with a hefty mineral component. This is a dry wine with a spicy, sweet nose that is nicely balanced by crisp acidity. 2023: 99 points, *Double Gold Medal & Best of Region White* - *CA State Fair*; 92 points & *Gold Medal* - *Sunset Intl Wine Competition*; 00 points - *BTI* 750 ml stelvin
